COACH BILL BELICHICK:

I thought this game was very similar to the Steeler game from last week. I thought it was a really hard fought game for both teams...there was a lot of good hitting out there. It was kind of one of those old fashioned games, a little rain, a little mud, a lot of running the ball. a lot of hard hitting, a lot of good aggressive defense on both teams and I thought we were very fortunate to make the plays. ~~with~~ Kevin Mack ran the ball real well. Kevin Mack ran the ball well for us in the second half. Eric made a couple of big plays, and Mike threw it well. And of course, defensively, I don't think we can say enough about the way they've played for the last four games. I have to give a lot of credit to Nikk Saban, like I told him after the game, whatever he's been doing, keep doing it. I think he has done a really good job and those guys are playing extremely well.

ON THE PERFORMANCE OF THE OFFENSIVE LINE:

~~xxxxxx~~ I'd really like to look at the film, but overall I think our running game was as efficient this year as it has been really in the past two years, there were really some good holes in there, the backs ran well, and there were a couple of audibles at the line that Mike did a real good job of finding. We hit their soft spot in the defense, I thought it was a really good team effort running the ball with the tight-end, the line, the backs, the quarterback - they were all involved in it. Hal Hunter, Steve Crosby, Ernie Adams they are the ones responsible for ~~making~~ coaching these people and they did a really good job.

ON MIKE TOMZAK:

Mike's been doing well since he got here. The first game against Denver he was really hand cuffed, but in the short amount of time he's been here he has really made progress each week, and he is really doing a heck of a job for us... I hate to think where we would be without him.

ON THE DEFENSE:

It is team defense. It is team defense all the way. If everybody takes care of their responsibility ~~than~~ you can function well as a team. It starts up front, you've got to do a good job on the running, and keep constant pressure on the passing, Of course, the linebackers work off of them, they do a good job against the run and matching up for us in the short zones. Our secondary is a pretty good tackling secondary and we haven't given up many big plays so even though they've hit some passes and that type of thing, which everybody is going to do we do a good job of tackling and being around the ball. I'd say the biggest thing is everybody plays 100%, they play with a lot of effort and when they snap the ball, we run to it until the whistle blows, the more guys you have around it the better chance you have of making plays and not missing tackles.

ON LAWYER TILLMAN

I guess any time you are out that long, the first catch is the big one, and that certainly was a big one for us. It was a big play on the drive, Lawyer has been catching the ball well the last couple of weeks in practice. He has our defensive backs hanging on him and he has taken some hits in practice, and that type of thing. It's probably good to get that type of thing out of the way, but I don't think it surprised anybody that he made it. He's been ~~making~~ making them pretty regularly in practice.

ON RON WOLFELY (WHO THROUGH KEY BLOCKS ON BOTH TOUCHDOWNS)

I thought Ron did a good job of filling in for Leroy Hoard in some of regular offense and our two tight end offense. He made some nice blocks early in the game on inside gains and then later on in the game on some of the outside plays. Ron is a good blocker and he made a good catch out there in the flat. He is a great special teams player. I think he as much as anybody epitomizes what a Cleveland Browns is or should be. He is a real ~~xxx~~ good team player, a great effort player, a hard worker, a real tough football player.

ON THREE STRAIGHT QUARTERS WITHOUT ALLOWING A TOUCHDOWN:

I think it is something maybe you can look back on and be proud of, but I think the defense really goes out there play to play and tries to play well. You don't worry about whether they scored last quarter, or thirteen quarters ago. They only thing you can control is what they do on this coming play. When you do that, then sometimes you end up with something like what we've got. I don't think three weeks ago anybody was looking at this and I think if we look ahead to try and make it more than this and don't play it play to play, that it will probably come to a screeching halt.

POST GAME QUOTES

COACH MIKE HOLMGREN .....

It seems like a broken record, but we're not mature enough as a team yet to overcome the kind of mistakes we had like the fumbles down in close where I had hoped we'd get some points. Today a couple of offsides penalties hurt us. We could have gotten our defense off the field.

It was a close game, but I have to give the credit to Cleveland. They played a great game. They went on two or three great drives and did what they had to do to get points on the board.

Well, I think when you lose two players like that (Bennett and Milliard), it's bound to affect you. I just told the team, there are no excuses. Sure, they are two good players, and it would have been nice to have them, but the game goes on.

REGARDING THE SAFETIES MAKING SO MANY TACKLES ON KEVIN MACK .....

Well, I think if the safeties have to tackle him too much, then we're not doing a real good job up front. If you are a safety weighing 150 pounds and had to tackle him a lot, you'd wear down. But our guys are tough guys.

Cleveland did a nice job sustaining drives and keeping the ball out of our hands. And I think that was the key to the game. I don't think fatigue was a factor for our defense because it was cold so you weren't drained by the cool weather.

I think Cleveland ran, oh say, 55 plays or something like that. They didn't get too tired.

REGARDING MIKE TOMCZAK .....

I told Mike after the game that he played a really great game. He did exactly what he had to do to win the ballgame. I'd say that I really thought that Mike Tomczak would be playing for me this year, but he's a great young man, a fine person and quarterback, and I enjoyed working with him, and I wish him luck with the Browns

COACH NICK SABAN

ON THE THIRTEEN QUARTER STREAK

I don't think the 13 quarter streak of no touchdowns is really a significant factor. it's not to me. i think the first thing you have to do is say the players have done an outstanding job of preparing, working hard, and they deserve all the credit, as well as the other coaches on the staff, who have done an excellent job with the defensive lines, line backers and that type of thing. The front has made ~~xxxx~~ drastic imprvoement . Getting Frank back today obviously helped, but the people wo have filled in have done an ousstanding job in the secondary. At times we have given up more yards than we'd like, but our made objective on defense is ~~xxxxxxxx~~ to not allow a score We have been fortuante to be able to do that. But again I think ~~xxx~~ the players, the leadership we get from Mike Johnson, Clay Matthews, Michael Dean, Vince Newsome, Frank Minnifield, those kind of ~~xxxxxx~~ people, not only on the field but in the preparation and the leadership they give the other players are all significant factors in making us be successsful. I think the njmber one thing we want to do is win football games, I am not really interested in how many quarters they don't score - I just don't want them to score any more than for what ~~xxxxxxxxxxxx~~ gives us an opportunity to win. i think that is the most important thing. I think it is a rallying point for the players. I think it is something they are proud of, and they very well should be proud ofit it is a ~~very~~ big accomplsihment for them and I am very proud of them for being able to do it.

MIKE TOMCZAK

ON HIS GREEN BAY KNOWLEDGE:

It doesn't turn out to be much of a factor if you don't execute. I think in the back of my mind going into the game I have a lot of respect for Green Bay, they are a good football team, but it was up to us to just take charge for three hours. You go out there and dominate things. We had a tough time the second quarter on, and then we came out of the game in the third quarter and things started to jell for us. The running game continues to get better. It's gotten better in time. I think they guy up front deserve a lot of credit. I told you people last week to give them some credit and some people did, but hopefully this week you'll give them a little bit more. No sacks again this week. It's kind of getting to be a redundant thing. I hope they can do that for another 10 or 11 weeks.

ON THE THIRD DOWN PASS TO MARK BAVARO:

We had two plays called actually, one when we went into the huddle, we were all set for it and like right before when the ref blow the whistle we changed the play again from the sideline and it wasn't a pretty pass to Mark, but we put it in ~~xxxxxxx~~ throughout the course of the week - Mark had one on one coverage and made a big play for us.

ON HIS SECOND VICTORY AT QB

Any victory is rewarding. I think it is great for the organization. Again, it's great for the state and the city of Cleveland, but it's important for me to keep on winning games for this organization. I think they brought me in here to make things happen - it couldn't be done without a strong defense, it couldn't be done without a great running game, and a great passing game so it's a great team victory and I'm just happy to be aboard this ball club.

ON GETTING SOME ZIP AFTER STRUGGLING:

Not really, I was ready to go from the onset, You know we took an opening drive and went down 70 yards and came away with a field goal, we just fell short of a couple of completions. But you know I felt very comfortable out there. When you stop yourself on drives than you start to ask yourself some questions, but we're a good football team and we're getting ~~xxx~~ better every week and that's what it amounts to.

ON YOUR CONVERSATION WITH MIKE HOMLGREN AFTER THE GAME:

I have a lot of respect for Mike Homlgren, he gave me a chance in Green bay, of course it didn't work out but, I've always liked him every since the day I met him and it was nice of him to come over and talk to me. It felt good, he said congratulations and he was happy for me. That's satisfying too when a head coach comes over to you and tells you those things...it's very meaningful, but it's all for not if you don't play well. I'm happy..you now there are friends on the other side of the ball, on the other side of the field today but you have to put that aside for three hours and go out there and concentrate and ~~xxxxxx~~ stay focused on what you try to accomplish out there.

Throught the course of the week I studied computer printouts to know what they are trying to down on second down and third down and the coach did a good job preparing us for it and we just had to go out there and execute it.

ON KEVIN MACK:

He's job to watch. I enjoy hadning the football off becasuse I know one thing, I I'm not getting hit. It's up to the guys up front to make room for him and with that in mind...here's Kevin Mack.

KEVIN MACK:

HOW DO YOU THINK YOU PLAYED?

I think it was okay, it could have been better. I think the way we were rotating backs in and out is a big plus to our team right now and I was lucky enough to be able to catch the good breaks.

ON YOUR TOUCHDOWN RUNS:

They were pretty much the same plays except for one we had a wham, Wolfley was coming in whamming one of the down lineman and the other was a basic play that we run, you know one of our bread and butter plays, but of them pretty much evolved the same way where I broke them outside, not real far outside, but outside where it kind of opened up - everybody seemed to be collapsing and so I just ran where the hole was.

WERE THEY DESIGNED TO GO OUT THERE?

No, not really. It's pretty much I saw. It's a read play, I read it, that's where the hole was, that where I took it.

ON THE MEDIA SAYING YOU WERE GOING TO GET TRADED FROM IR:

I think everybody realizes that right now, I don't want to dig up anything from the past that going to cause anybody any problems, that's going to piss me off, that's going to piss you off...so I'll just leave it at that

I'M NOT TRYING TO GET YOU TO DO THAT -

I know that. I don't think it is going to benefit me to go back and say you know you guys did this and you guys did that and you shouldn't have...you guys have a job to do and that's your right...my right is to go out and play football, and I can't change your mind.

ON SEEING LAWYER COME BACK:

I was very happy for him, I think everybody was. When he caught the ball and I realized who caught it everybody on the team wanted to run down and pat him on the head, and I did that - I think it made him feel good - it's going to boost his confidence and it will help us down the road in the season..

ON MIKE TOMCZAK'S RUNNING OF THE OFFENSE

He's doing a great job, to come in and have to play as soon as he did, to kind of grasp the offense week by week and he's kind of learned more and more as the week went on...he's starting to get a grasp of it, but there are still a few things he has to learn. I think he is going to be a good quarterback for us down the line, as Bernie heals up and Mike progresses, it's going to be interesting.

AFTER GREEN BAY TIED IT WHAT WAS THE MINDSET OF THE OFFENSE:

I was pretty mad, I was pretty angry because at that point we should have been farther ahead, we pretty much self destructed on offense. I think the offensive lineman knew it, the running backs knew it, the receivers knew it, at that ~~point~~ point we should have been further ahead. It was just a matter of what's going on and executing our plays and just taking our time about it and now getting impatient, and not make a whole lot of exciting things happen too soon, taking it bit by bit and that's what we did in the second half.

DO YOU FEEL FRESHER THAN YOU NORMALLY WOULD:

Yeah, I feel a little fresher. After last week, betting back in, the soreness and everything after a game, you get the beatings, it reminds you and kinds of slows you down a little bit, it slowed me down a little bit but I still feel fresher and I think the way the coaches are rotating our backfield and everybody's playing, it's helping us out. I think guys are probably avoiding little nagging injuries that would pop up.

ON GETTING THE BALL SO MANY TIMES: I think anybody likes getting the ball, if my numbers out I'm going to do that best I can in any situation.

ON THE POWER FORMATION (WITH THE TWO TIGHT ENDS) - I doesn't really make it easy on me if it's a running situation everybody knows who's going to get the ball, so I think the advantage we have as an offense it, at the snap count, we know where the play is going, the defense has to react, So you know it's just a matter of execution.

KEVIN MACK - CONTINUED

If we don't execute, we aren't going to get a good play, it's not going to be run right. I think we can run the ball on just about anybody, we can play against just about anybody.

ON THE BLOCKING YOU GOT TODAY:

Our offensive line did a great job today, every chance I got I was telling the guys, keep it up, if we had a bad play or a good play, whatever, keep it up. If it was a bad play, don't let it get you down. It was usually just because of little minor things, a guy might have overplayed his block and let the guy slide off or you know those are things that can be fixed. It's nothing to get discouraged about, I was just trying to keep them up - an upbeat team.

ON CAREER TOUCHDOWN # 50:

No. (I don't think about those things).

Out on the field I pretty much have job to do and I don't worry about ~~xxxxx~~ TD 50 or TD # 2 in a game or whatever. My job is to help the team win and that's what I try to do.

ON LEADERSHIP ROLE:

Yeah, I think a lot of players who were more quieter in the past who listened to the older guys when they were around - have to step up and be a little more assertive and help the younger guys along
